To ensure a better service to members and a saving in effort it is necessary to focus available resources more effectively and spread the workload to utilise all the available talent in Langstone. This is a matter which both association management teams have been examining.

The concept to be considered is the creation of a single Association for Langstone managed by a small committee and supported by various specialist working groups. This would allow focused attention on subject areas by members with a strong interest in it, while allowing those individuals to avoid the necessity of being involved in 'committee work'!
